

## Questions submitted Week 25

Submitted questions are in black, and JWC responses are in blue.

1. I am looking for the format for resumes referred to in the file *IFIB-ACT-JWC-19-08 A Annexes to Part I.pdf* where we are pointed towards a "Supplier Bidding Forms and Resumes (Annex B-2 Supplier Compiled)" on page 3.

Should there be an Annex B-2 format for Resumes -- I cannot find it?

**In accordance with Part I Bidding Instructions/Section 11 Contents of Proposal b. Envelope B, "Each prospective bidder shall include a technical proposal to include as a minimum the following information: b.2 Candidates resumes and their corresponding Technical Evaluation Matrixes for each Exercise Play Function in accordance with SOW Attachment A: Exercise Play Function Book. (Annex B-2 – Company created & compiled)**

**We do not have a specific resume template. Companies should fill out the Technical Evaluation Matrix (which may be cut from the Exercise Play Book) and refer to the resume as needed. Any candidate who meets all the technical requirements in their corresponding Technical Evaluation Matrix will be considered an "accepted resume". Resumes will not be independently reviewed, but rather a supplement to the filled in Technical Matrix.**

2. I have established a new company. The primary partners are former contractors to JWC.
  - a. Will you see the new established company as a valid bidder according to JWC regulations for this bid?
  - b. We will of course include "Past performance Information Form – Annex B-3" for all the companies in our bid.

**The B-3 compliancy from Page 9 of the Solicitation states " Minimum 1 similar past performance effort in the last 4 years for like services". If former contractors to JWC, have established a new company, and performed similar services to those described in the SOW, then yes, the newly established company would be considered compliant for the B-3 technical compliance.**

3. Concerning the bid itself. In order to be regarded as a valid partial bidder we must bid for a minimum of 15 different EPFs. Is it accepted that the same individual can cover more than 1 EPF?

**Yes, the same individual can be offered for more than 1 Exercise Play Function assuming they meet the requirements for both functions.**

4. According to you letter IFIB-ACT-JWC-19-08 PART II, GENERAL PROVISIONS, 3. AUTHORIZAZION TO PERFORM; our company and Sub-Contractors should warrant that we are authorized to perform the required services and to do business in Norway. Last time I participated in a similar

matter (Trident Javelin 2017) I presented the certificate as seen below. Is it the same type of documentation you need for this bid?

**In order to bid, a company does not need to provide any additional documentation to prove they meet the requirements of Part II 3. Authorization to Perform. If a company is awarded the contract, then JWC may ask to see proof that you have a corporate registration in Norway.**

5. And a minor one. Last time we could use a JWC bus from Stavanger to JWC and back on a daily basis. Will the same convenience be provided for the coming exercises?
