

Questions submitted Week 27

Submitted questions are in black, and JWC responses are in blue.

In your reply to Question 2 of the IFIB-ACT-JWC-19-08 Questions Submitted Week 25 (below), you referred to the B-3 Compliancy Form from Page 9 of the solicitation where it states “Minimum 1 similar past performance effort in the last 4 years for like services”. Can you confirm that the 1 similar past performance effort in the past 4 years for **LIKE SERVICES** includes in size and scope as well and that **LIKE SERVICES** does not refer to the provision of a single STOC for one or more exercises but multiple STOCs (between the 5 and 15 you refer to in the technical compliance portion) for multiple exercises, which would be more reflective of **LIKE SERVICES**?

2. I have established a new company. The primary partners are former contractors to JWC.

a. Will you see the new established company as a valid bidder according to JWC regulations for this bid?

b. We will of course include “Past performance Information Form – Annex B-3” for all the companies in our bid.

The B-3 compliancy from Page 9 of the Solicitation states “Minimum 1 similar past performance effort in the last 4 years for like services”. If former contractors to JWC have established a new company, and performed similar services to those described in the SOW, then yes, the newly established company would be considered compliant for the B-3 technical compliance.

The “like services” refer to a comparable service to JWC 9or other NATO-entity; comparable as in “size/numbers and content of the service provided”. Indeed NOT the provision of one single STOC somewhere in the last years.
